USE OF CABINS

THE USE OF THE CABINS IS A PRIVILEGE, NOT A RIGHT. EVEN WHEN YOU ARE THE FIRST TO ARRIVE YOU SHOULD EXPECT TO SHARE THE CABIN WITH OTHERS. MAKE THEM WELCOME. THERE IS ALWAYS ROOM FOR ONE MORE. IF OVER- FLOWING, TRY TO TAKE TURNS BOTATING IN AND OUT.

LOG BOOKS

PLEASE SIGN IN WHEN YOU VISIT. THIS WILL ASSIST FORRS IN FUTURE PROJECTS.

FIREWOOD

AS WOOD IS IN SHORT SUPPLY AT SOME CABINS, PLEASE USE JUST WHAT YOU NEED FOR YOUR VISIT. TO PRESERVE THE FLOORS AND DECKS PLEASE SPLIT WOOD AND KINDLING ON THE CHOPPING BLOCK NEAR THE WOODSHEDS. ALWAYS ENSURE THAT THERE IS AN ADEQUATE SUPPLY OF DRY FIRE WOOD AND KINDLING IN THE CABIN WHEN YOU LEAVE.

KEEPING THE CABIN CLEAN

PLEASE PACK OUT WHAT YOU HAVE PACKED IN. SWEEP THE FLOOR AND LEAVE IT AS TIDY AS YOU WOULD LIKE TO HAVE FOUND IT. AS IN THE ENTIRE REC AREA "LEAVE NO TRACE".

CANDLES

CANDLES ARE A MAJOR FIRE HAZARD. USE IS DISCOURAGED BUT IF USED PLEASE USE THE SAUCERS PROVIDED, OR A CANDLE HOLDER WITH A DISH.PLEASE PACK OUT ALL USED CANDLE HOLDERS. HEAD LIGHTS / LANTERNS ARE MUCH FRIENDLIER AND SAFER.
